

## KENN PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on Monday 6th April 2009 in the Village Hall at 8.00 p.m.

### **Present:**

Apologies were received from Ms. J. Smith

P.C. Kinsella addressed the meeting and presented the crime figures for the year 2008/09. There had been 42 reported crimes of which 16 had taken place on a licensed premises. This was a reduction of 5 overall on the previous year. There have been changes to the Trading Standards laws which make it easier to deal with bogus callers. Parishioners were urged to call the Police if there were any incidents. The Parish had been represented at the Police and Community Together initiative. The next meeting will be on June 30<sup>th</sup>. P.C. Kinsella was thanked and he left the meeting.

The minutes of the last Annual Parish Meeting were read and signed.

### **Matters arising:**

Warrens Holiday Village. The planning conditions have been changed and the site will be open for twelve months of the year but no resident can use it as their permanent address. This was considered to be already being abused and impractical to enforce. Mr. Moulin will speak to the Planning Officer.

Flood Action Group. Mr. Griffin and others have attended meeting of the group and found them useful. There are to be changes at the Sea Wall at Kingston Seymour to abandon a small piece of land to the sea in order to prevent erosion later. There are 5 schemes proposed for the Channel.

Electricity Supply. The problems have been alleviated.

### **Financial statement:**

The financial statement was circulated and approved.

### **Best Kept Village Competition:**

Kenn will enter the competition again this year. Volunteers will be asked to help tidy up the village on 9<sup>th</sup> May. This will be advertised as widely as possible.


### **Parish Plan:**
